Mayor Collins opened the meeting at 12:30 pm.

A motion was presented by Trustee Binder, seconded by Trustee Kates to accept the Minutes of July 3, 2023, as presented. Unanimous.

A motion was presented by Trustee Kates, seconded by Trustee Binder, to pay bills on General Fund Abstract \$15,471.32, Water Fund Abstract in the amount of \$2,202.98, and Sewer Fund Abstract in the amount of \$26,083.52. Unanimous.

There were no public comments.

Rich Manley from Fusco Engineering reported that a car hit Grand Savings Store and that the building has been deemed safe to resume business. Jim is working on garbage violation citations.

Steve Valestro from H2O Innovations reported that Sewer Plant is working well with the repairs they did, they need to do a rag cleanup from the filters. Well #3 is back on line, there was a discussion with the Village Board regarding the Sulphur smell coming from some residences; Steve will look into this matter.

Attorney Kaplan reported that the dispute from 87 Highland is coming closer to a resolution, he will forward the proposal to have the Village Board review and comment. The Town of Fallsburg has not responded to his email regarding the Davos Contract, he will send another email.

Brenda Cohn reported that the tax bill relevies are completed. Catskill Hudson has increased the interest on all bank accounts to 3%, and 4% on the ICS account.

Tommy Decker reported that the DPW trimmed back the brush on the Rails to Trails. They were patching on Broadway & Maple, and have also replaced another out of service fire hydrant.

Trustee Binder commented on the lack of voltage in the Village during the summer; the office is waiting for a call back from NYSEG.
