Attorney Kaplan reported that he has sent another strong letter to the Town of Fallsburg regarding the Davos Contract and their lack of communication with the Village; he will keep the Village Board members apprised of the anticipated response from the Town.

A motion was presented by Trustee Binder, seconded by Trustee Kates, to authorize Mayor Collins to sign the proposal for Engineering Services for EPG Funded Sanitary Sewer Collection System Evaluation. Unanimous.

The Village Hall rental rates will be revisited at another time.

Mayor Collins reported that the traffic signal at Mountindale & Glen Wild Roads, need to be repaired by the County; The County feels we will have to replace this signal next year at a cost of approximately \$16, 000.

Mayor Collins also reported that we received a \$20,000 grant from Sullivan 180 for various projects for the park.

There being no further business a motion was presented by Trustee Kates, seconded by Trustee Binder to adjourn the meeting at 6:20 pm. Unanimous.
