BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
Regular Meeting  
September 5, 2023

Present: Mayor Joan Collins, Deputy Mayor Leni Binder, Trustees Ronald Kates, Yaacov Levine, and Louis Saperstein.

Also Present: Attorney Jeffrey Kaplan, Brenda Cohn, and Myra Bennett.

Mayor Collins opened the meeting at 6:00 pm.

A Moment of Silence was held for Jared Proyect, and Jeanne Becker-Feldman, Village residents.

A motion was presented by Trustee Kates, seconded by Trustee Binder, to accept the Minutes of August 21, 2023, as presented. Unanimous.

A motion was presented by Trustee Binder, seconded by Trustee Kates, to pay bills on General Fund Abstract in the amount of \$35,209.67, Water Fund Abstract in the amount \$22,834.32, Sewer Fund Abstract in the amount of 30,817.23, and the Dam Fund in the amount of \$4,000. Unanimous.

There were no public comments.

Myra Bennett reported that we have 5.73 tons available for Fall Cleanup this year.

Attorney Kaplan had a discussion with the Board regarding the Village Grass Law that states grass has to be cut when it reaches 6". He recommends, that the violation letters get sent out earlier; still giving the residents 7 days to respond.

Brenda Cohn reported that 71% of the Village Taxes have been received and that the Budget report has been sent electronically to the Village Board on Tuesday, September 5, 2023.

Mayor Collins appointed Trustees Binder and Levine to audit the Village of Woodridge's Court Books for fiscal year 2022, date to be determined.

Mayor Collins reported that the Village Comprehensive Plan committee meetings are continuing to make progress.

Mayor Collins reported that Mr. Robert Krutman copied a picture of the Village (1960's) taken from a plane, and labeled all the resident's homes and the businesses that were in the Village at that time. It will be place in the History Wall.

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Trustee Saperstein had some suggestions for residents to keep up their property maintenance, and for the newly renovated baseball field.

There was a discussion regarding overnight parking law, during the winter season, Attorney Kaplan will report back to the Village Board with some suggestions.

A motion was presented by Trustee Binder, seconded by Trustee Kates, to adjourn to Executive Session, to discuss a contractual matter, not to reconvene. Unanimous.
