Deputy Mayor Leni Binder opened the meeting at 6:00pm.

A motion was presented by Trustee Weiss, seconded by Trustee Kates, to accept the Minutes of September 16, 2024, as presented. Unanimous.

A motion was presented by Trustee Kates, seconded by Trustee Weiss, to pay bills on General Fund Abstract in the amount of \$23,486.90, Water Fund Abstract in the amount of \$20,086.90, and Sewer Fund Abstract in the amount of \$45,536.45, Silver Lake Treatment in the amount of \$5,000.00. Police Chief John Cavello discussed police action on the Rail Trail.

Mr. Decker informed the board that the DPW will start road repairs on Glen Wild Road this week, starting on Wednesday. Green Ave will be closed from Oct 30th-Nov 1st for road repair as well.

Deputy Treasurer Brown gave a summary of the NYCOM Fall Training.

Treasurer Cohn stated unpaid tax notices will be going out the end of October. Auditors have begun on the Annual Financial Report that will be submitted to the Office State Controller soon.

Attorney Jeff Kaplan discussed more on the proposed annexation; this will be tabled for a later time.

The Woodridge Seniors will meet at the Village Hall on Monday evenings; they will be having a Penny Social on November 16th at 2:00pm, calling starts at 4:00pm.
