A motion was presented by Trustee Kates, seconded by Trustee Saperstein, to pay bills on General Fund Abstract in the amount of \$73,777.01, Water Fund Abstract in the amount of \$16,605.19, and Sewer Fund Abstract in the amount of \$39,996.32. Unanimous.

Attorney Kaplan recapped the meeting with the Town of Fallsburg regarding the Davos Sewer Contract, he feels that progress was made; the proposed settlement would be that, the next two billings the Town of Fallsburg will be billed as an outside user, after that they will be billed directly off the master meter. Attorney Kaplan will continue to update the Village Board.

A motion was presented by Trustee Binder, seconded by Trustee Kates, to hold a public hearing on April 3, 2023 at 6:05 pm, to consider Real Property Tax Exemption for senior citizens. Unanimous.
